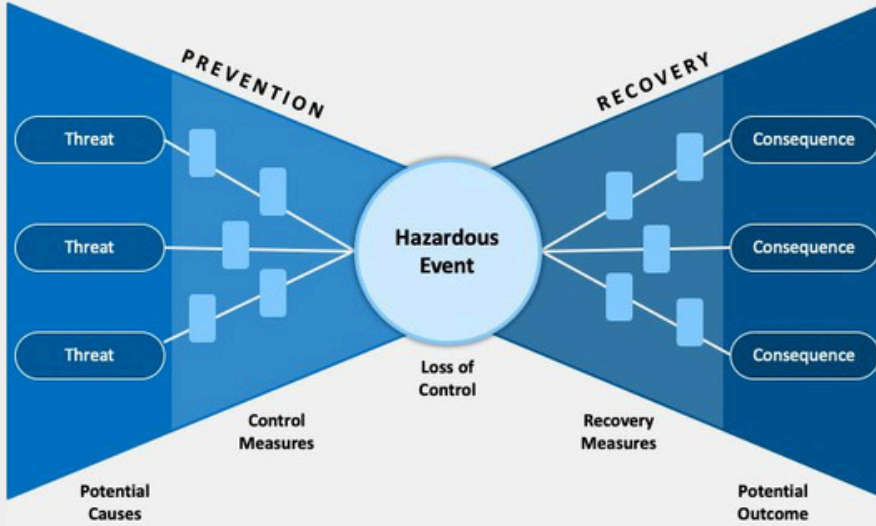

Barrier-Based Risk Management

The bowtie methodology is designed to provide the right level of detail to facilitate understanding and risk-based decision making, without oversimplifying a process.

Bowties are visual representations of causal pathways that link hazards, causes and controls to unwanted events and their potential consequences.

They are increasingly used by mining companies to analyse the effectiveness of control measures.
